Assembly



Remove Headstock **And Neck From Pockets & Assemble** The Neck

* ensure strings aren't wrapped around the neck

Insert Assembled Neck Into The Slot And Click Into Place

* ensure strings sit properly in the saddle slots so your string spacing and action is



Fully Tighten The Knob On The Back And Tune To Play

*tighten fully so there is no gap between neck and body to get the lowest action

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
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Disassembly



Unscrew Main Bolt Knob On Back

* if the bolt is tight, press neck against body with other hand while untightening the knob. Changes in humidity or temp can make joint tight



- *if bolt isn't unscrewed fully, unscrew back bolt further for the latch to disengage
- * If it's hard to press, push neck against the body with other hand



Place Body In Case, **Detch Headstock** And Neck

* if you've removed the headstock pocket for assembled carry, insert it after guitar body is in position

Put Headstock & Neck In Pockets, & Put Panel On Top

- * headstock pocket position as shown
- *secure strings on top with velcro tab to protect finish



After Zipping Guitar Case, Place Neck In Laptop/Cargo Area

*there's an elastic chord to the right of the computer pocket to hold neck sleeve in place

Assembled Carry



Slide Neck Sleeve **Over Guitar Neck & Unzip Case Top Zipper**

* top zipper opening is for neck sleeve to slide through *the long flap on the neck sleeve should face forward



- *place panel behind neck sleeve
- *remove headstock pocket if carrying assembled guitar



Zip The Guitar Case Shut And Clip Outside Straps

- *Velcro should secure neck sleeve *place headstock pocket in cargo
- *if raining, pack guitar disassembled & use rain cover

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
